- The specific areas that will be funded are announced in the Work Programme through calls for proposals
- All calls can be found in the Funding & Tender Portal
- Each call gives you specific information on the questions that are to be addressed in a proposal
- Make sure your proposal fully fits the call description and topics within the Work Programme




Identify your topic!





Topic description – conditions and documents



Matching exercise

After a clear formulation of the project idea, a matching exercise with the potential open or forthcoming selected topic needs to be executed from your side.

- Does your idea have a significant impact (almost) identical to the expected impact of the topic?
- Does your idea tackle the challenge described in the topic description?
- Actions foreseen from your side are similar to the ones described in the topic? Do you have a common understanding in terms of costs and time with the topic?

3. Topics flagged for International Cooperation?





How to identify topics flagged for International Cooperation?

- In some cases, topics in the Work Programme **encourage**International Cooperation and state explicitly that 'this will be positively considered during the evaluation of proposals'.
- International Cooperation is a cross-cutting priority and included in almost all parts of Horizon 2020
- All flagged topics are defined as such in the Funding & Tender Portal







- Submission forms and templates: essential forms and guides to draw up and submit your proposal
- Guide to the submission and evaluation process

2. Eligibility and admissibility conditions: described in Annex B and Annex C of the Work Programme.








How to participate – Where to find help?

- **C. Beneficiary register**: list of all beneficiaries participating in the EU R&I, education, and culture programmes (search for already registered organisations and their PICs)





Please check whether your organisation has already been registered. If so, no need to register it again.




- Beneficiaries need to register and receive a 9-digit

- Quote your PIC in all correspondence with the Commission!

Register your organisation

To register, you need to login in the Portal or, if you are a new user, create your account.

Check what information you need to register in the Online Manual - and keep it to hand d registration procedure. To start registration, click on the button below.




You can suspend the registration process at any time: the data entered can be saved as can continue your registration later. To return to your registration, please log in and get in Organisation(s) in the My Area section. Incomplete, draft registrations are automatically one year.

For H2020 programme, please make sure to fill in the H2020 and FP7 section in the Part Register. Additionally, for actions where the SME status is an eligibility criterion (like, e.g. Instrument) you must also carry out the SME self-assessment.

Should your project be successfully evaluated, the registered data will be verified by the Service team before the signature of the Grant Agreement.




National Contact Points


- The network of National Contact Points (NCPs) is the main structure to provide guidance, practical information and assistance on all aspects of participation in Horizon 2020.
- Established also in many non-EU and non-associated countries "international partner countries".
- Personalised support on the spot and in applicants' own languages for all aspects regarding Horizon 2020 participation
- Organise workshops and information events
- Established, operated and financed by EU Member States, associated countries and third countries
- Nominated by national ministries to the European Commission
