Topic: Optimised and systematic energy management in electric vehicles GV-2-2014

Topic Description | Topic Conditions & Documents | Submission Service

Specific challenge: Range limitation, due to the limited storage capacity of electric batteries, is one of the major drawbacks of electric vehicles. The main challenge will be to achieve a systematic energy management of the vehicle based on the integration of components on a sub-systems. The problem is worsened by the need to use part of the storage capacity in order to feed auxiliary equipment such as climate control. In extreme conditions up to 30% of the batteries' capacity is absorbed by these systems. The systematic management of energy in electric vehicles is a means to gain extended range without sacrificing comfort. The challenge is therefore to extend the range of electric vehicles in all weather conditions.

Scope: Proposals should address the combination of the following developments: comprehensive thermal management system (including thermal insulation, innovative heating and cooling approaches), battery duration enhancement as a side effect of thermal management, electronic control of energy and/or flow, energy efficiency of electrified accessories, energy harvesting functions and automated and driving strategies.

The Commission considers that proposals requesting a contribution from the EU of between EUR 3 to 8 million each would allow this specific challenge to be addressed appropriately. Nonetheless, this does not preclude submission and selection of proposals requesting other amounts.

Expected impact: Research and innovation activities will contribute to a faster introduction of electric and hybrid cars. Cars autonomy will be increased thanks to a reduction of at least 30% of energy used for passenger comfort and at least 30% for component cooling in extreme conditions with reference to the vehicles currently on the market.

Step 1 - Find a suitable Call for Proposals H2020 ONLINE MANUAL

The Commission publishes on the Participant Portal all the Calls of its research and innovation programmes H2020, and you can search calls from previous programmes (FP7 and CIP). In addition you can find information about some additional calls in the **Other Funding Opportunities** section. If you apply for the first time and do not know yet the programmes, it is useful to read the H2020 Online Manual. It helps you choose the most suitable programme for your area and profile. Besides, you can search according to your research topic with key words and set filters in the calls list.

Your National Contact Point can also help you find the most suitable call for your profile. SMEs are in addition supported by the Enterprise Europe Network.

Step 2 - Find project partners or apply as an individual team or researcher
